The GP for 2025-2026 season has had a facelift

It was noted that divisions were getting large, and only 20% of the numbers in each division could realistically compete for a top 3 place.

We have reduced numbers in each division and increased divisions to 10. Thus giving more people a chance to push for a top 3 place

Runners have been grouped, based on average points scored from the past 10 GP's, therefor:-

Group Avg Points 96-100 1 2 92-95 3 89-91 4 85-88 5 80-84 6 75-79 7 70-74 8 65-69 9 60-64 10 < 60

These were based on the first fixture of this season and the $2^{nd} - 10^{th}$ of last season.

Some people's avg points will have been affected because of things like injury, low turn out in GP, following training plans etc.

Some have been placed in divisions where we think they will thrive, even though their avg is different to the division their in.

For every race we will also have a spot prize. This will be given to the Xth placed person in the race. The number will be drawn/generated once the race has started or numbers in the race are know to the officials.

Below are race rules regarding the Grand Prix

- · Best 5 out of 8 races count
- Only the top 3 in each division win a prize
- You must complete at least 4 out of 8 races to qualify for a top 3 prize.
- All runners are responsible for checking their own results and informing the author before the next race.
- You have to be a paid up member to score any points.
- In the event of people finishing on equal points at the end of the season, the order will be decided on:
 - o Person winning the most head to head races
 - o If 1. above equal then a joint trophy
